| Camp chair (to take around the camp) | Sunblock |
| Water bottle | Flashlight |
| Tent (If a Scout does not have a tent we may use a Troop tent or extra) | Bug spray |
| Sleeping bag | Rain gear |
| Sleeping pad | Snacks |
| Clothes for 7 days (each day in a Ziploc bag) | Cap/hat |
| Bath towel, soap, shampoo, toothbrush, toothpaste (daily showers—A Scout is CLEAN!) | Personal face coverings (extra) |
| Necessary prescription medicine | Money for troop reimbursement—all purchases at Trading Post will be placed on Troop’s account (shirt orders due Sunday of camp) |

Troop Items: (Need help from families to pick up)

- Sanitizing wipes
- Extra hand sanitizer (in trailer)
- Sanitizing spray solution in a pump bottle (Normans)
- Cleaning cloths
- Nitrile gloves (Normans)
- Disposable/Biodegradable plates, cups, knives, forks, spoons (70 each)—use spaghetti dinner supplies?
- Extra cooking gas (tanks in trailer)
- Lantern
- Drink flavor sleeves

Need to bring yard games (label with your name) (croquet, soccer ball, horse shoes, bean bag toss, ladder ball, etc)
